

CARE FOR YOUR iXi BIKE

Regularly check that all bolts on the bike are fully secure and that none have rattled loose during the course of riding. For safety reasons it is important to tighten any loose bolts before riding the bike again.

Any mud splatter or dust can be cleaned off with a damp sponge or cloth using water with a little soap added as required.

Care for the iXi Drive System:

Care should be taken to avoid any build-up of debris in the drive sprockets. Precise mating of the belt with the sprockets is important for proper functioning. Build-up of debris on the sprockets can occur in wet, muddy or dusty conditions. Any debris can be easily cleaned off by flushing with water and a brush on the exposed sprockets while rotating the drive system.

Depending on the type and abrasive characteristic of the debris, excessive wear can be generated on the belt and the sprockets. This can be avoided by regular inspection of front and rear sprockets and cleaning as necessary.

Warning: Wear to the drive belt or sprockets caused by build up of debris can void the warranty.

Correct belt tension is important for proper functioning. Tension is correctly set and tested at the factory during the assembly process. No adjustments should be made to belt tension unless it is necessary to remove the rear wheel (for either tire/tube repairs or other routine maintenance)

If it is necessary to remove or replace the rear wheel, please refer to the web site, www.ixibike.com and see the on line instructions regarding belt tension under 'iXi drive belt maintenance'. Incorrect belt tension can reduce belt life and cause excessive strain on other components.

Under normal conditions and with proper care, the life of the belt and sprockets will exceed 5 years or 5,000 miles.

LIMITED WARRANTY

The iXi bike is covered by a manufacturer's warranty against defects for a period of one year from the date of sale to the original owner. This warranty covers any repair to correct a manufacturer's defect in material or workmanship. Specifically excluded are damage to wheels, tires, rims and tubes that occur while riding, as well as other wear and tear that might occur while handling or using the bicycle.

The special iXi Drive Belt is warranted to last for 5 years from the first time the bike is ridden, or 5,000 miles, whichever occurs first. This warranty does not cover failure to exercise reasonable care and cleaning attention as outlined in the Care and maintenance section of the iXi handbook on p 17 and 18.
